L. Nighttime Sighting	-25 Pts	25
M. Blinking Lights	-50 Pts	X
N. Red, Green, or White Lights (only if a combination of at least 2)	-50 Pts	X
O. Traveled in One Direction or a Straight Line	-50 Pts	X
P. Traveled at Conventional Speeds	-50 Pts	X
Q. Greater than 1,000 Yards Away	-25 Pts	X
R. Not Officially Reported Within 72 Hours	-50 Pts	X
S. Exhaust Plume and/or Engine-Like Sound	-75 Pts	X
T. Natural Phenomena (possibility of Venus, Meteor, or other reported celestial object)	-25 Pts	X
U. Weather Balloon (any reports of launches in vicinity that day)	-100 Pts	X
V. Flares or Lanterns (any reports of military exercises or lantern launches in vicinity that day)	-75 Pts	X
W. Potential Hoax or Deception (ie. conflicting evidence, contradictory testimony, suspicious video)	-250 Pts	X

\*Why or Why Not: Although there were only internal reports, they were still done so immediately, officially, and by highly credible individuals, so no points deducted for not coming forward to the public until years later.
